Rationale:




- Details knowledge, skills and behaviours expected from a trained paediatrician
- Highlights core competencies required of trainees

Achieving core competencies in uncommon conditions can prove challenging

<u>Methods:</u>

- Surveyed senior paediatric trainees (ST6-ST8) in deanery
- Incorporated high fidelity simulation teaching into the postgraduate teaching programme in RBHSC
- Online questionnaire seeking feedback



Findings:

• Feedback positive:

'These sessions enabled me to develop my confidence in the management of conditions which I rarely see in clinical practice'

> 'Challenging and educational'

'Rare case simulation training allows me to meet curriculum competencies which I have not previously been able to achieve'

 Next step – incorporate into regional teaching programme



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
