Development Rationale

- Continuous professional development
- Inter-professional learning general practitioners and practice nurses
- 3 months distance learning modules ICGP accredited, CAS scheme
- Excellent educational resource written, updated and delivered by local multidisciplinary specialists



#### Methods

Based on identified learning needs of gps and practice nurses in Ireland

- Diabetes in Primary Care
- Women's Health in Primary Care
- Cardiovascular Disease in Primary Care
- Each module run over 3 months distance learning through **BLACKBOARD**
- Consists of weekly online units with a discussion forum tutored by local specialist
- 2 clinical workshop days
- Assessment practical written assignments, including an audit and online participation



Findings

- Clinical Primary Care Modules first of its kind to be delivered by a National University
- Recognised as an excellent form of CPD for general practitioners
- Contribute considerably for external, internal, personal credits and audit for CAS
- Multidisciplinary local specialist tutoring builds relationship between primary and secondary care, supporting improved patient care.
