RATIONALE

1. Precarious health system (non qualified health workforce – not motivated).
2. Only medical school: National University of Equatorial Guinea (UNGE).
3. No specialist training programme.



Aim: pilot training programme for the basic specialities.

Key stake holders: the Ministry of Health and the UNGE.

METHODS

Phase 1: Medical congresses

Phase 2: Awarding of grants

Phase 3: Implementation of the training program



FINDINGS

Phase 1 (2012-2017): Excellent feedback from students and junior doctors.

Phase 2 (2014-2017): 15 grants awarded for visiting fellowships.

Phase 3: To be implemented on 2018.
