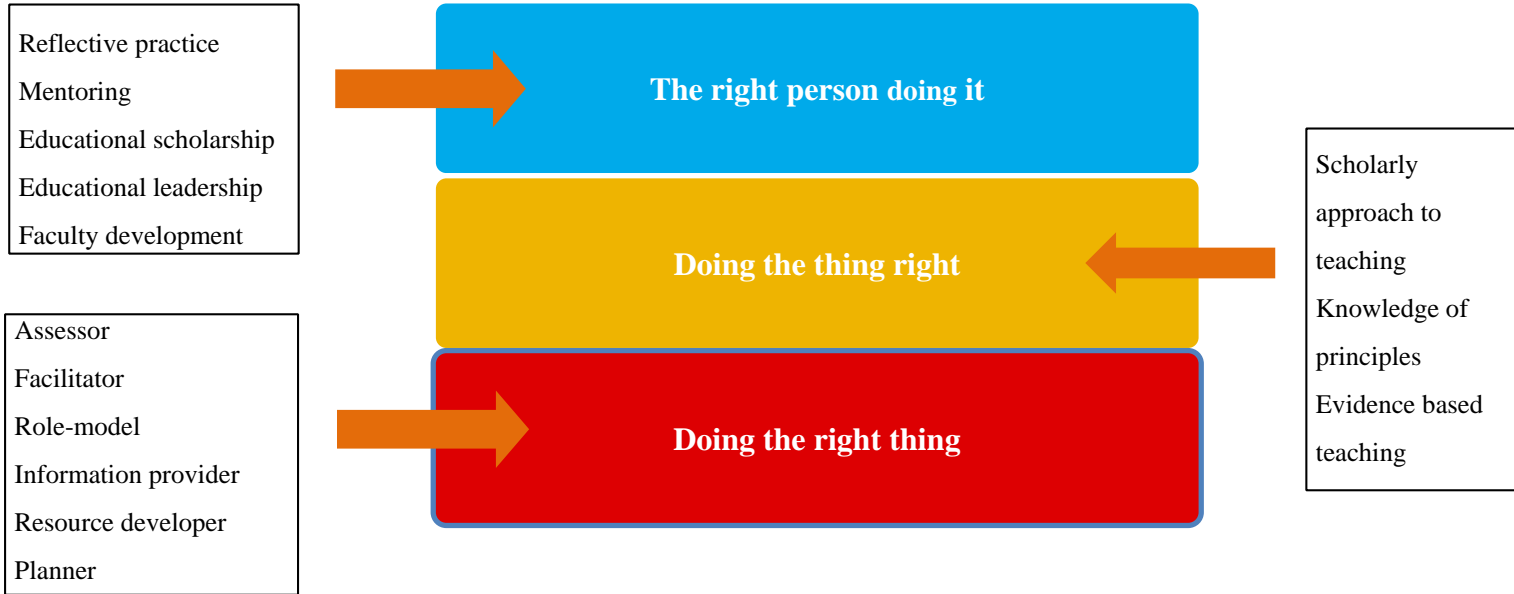

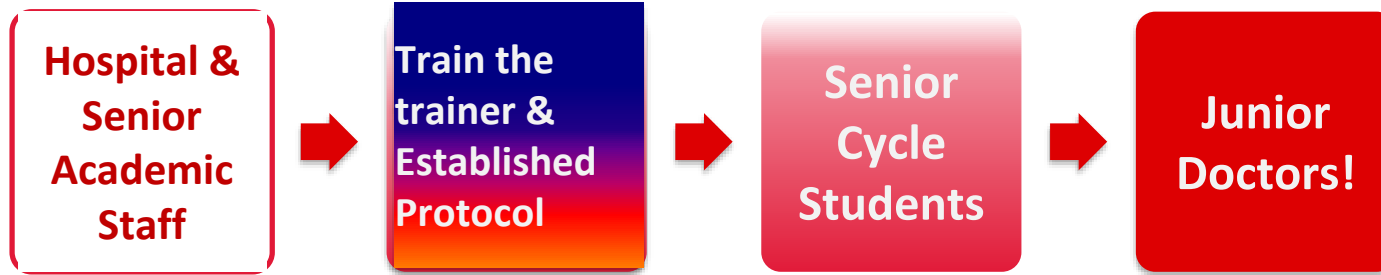

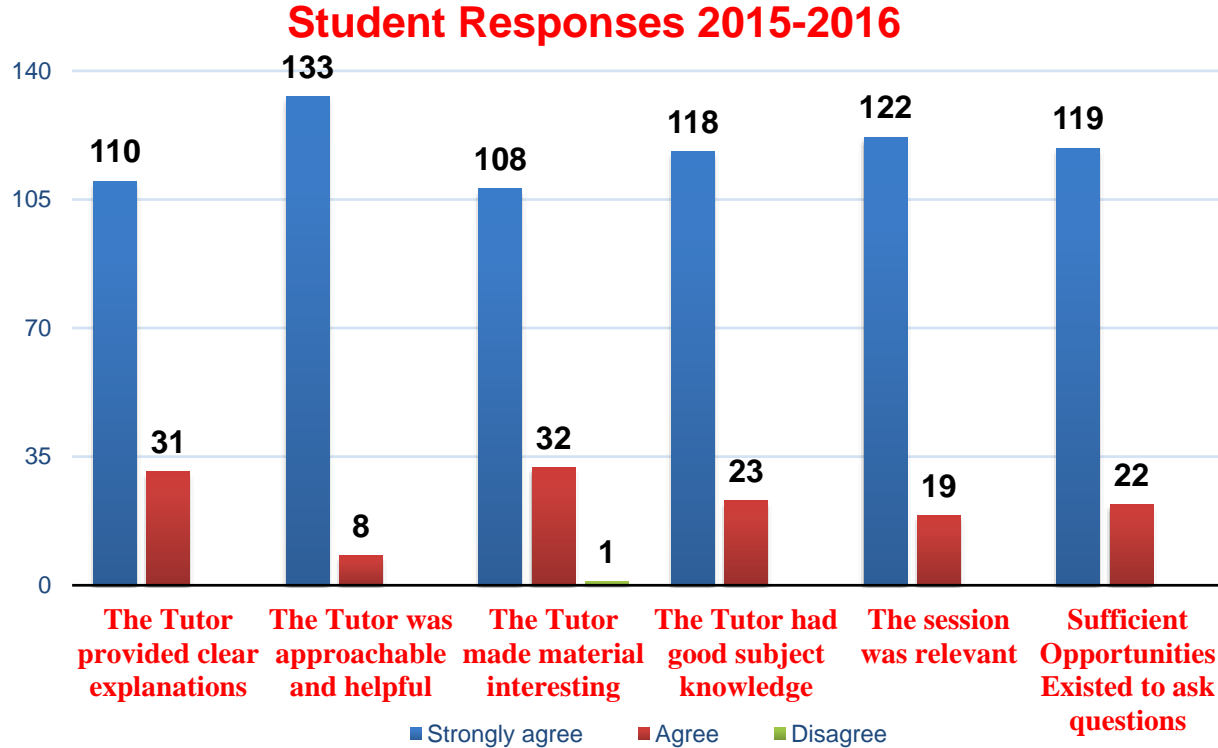


The Three circle model

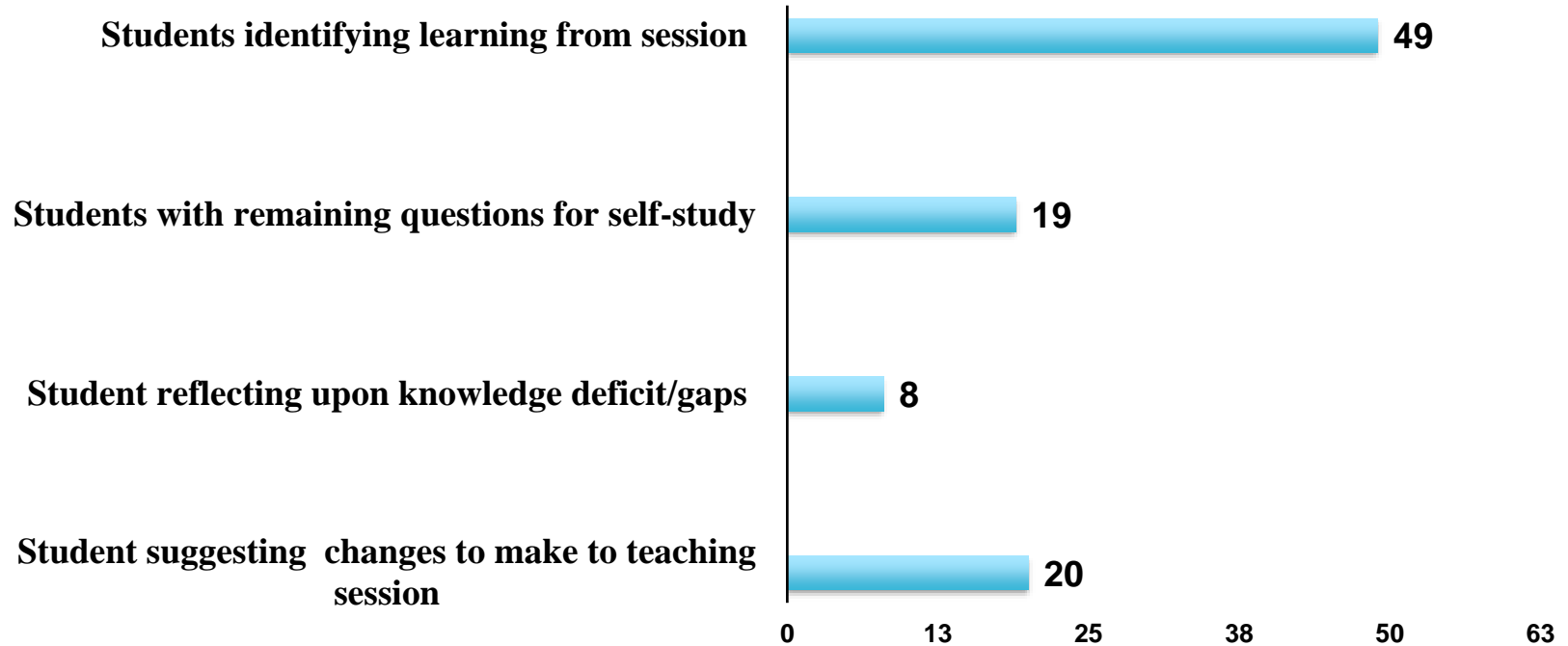


Results- Likert Scale

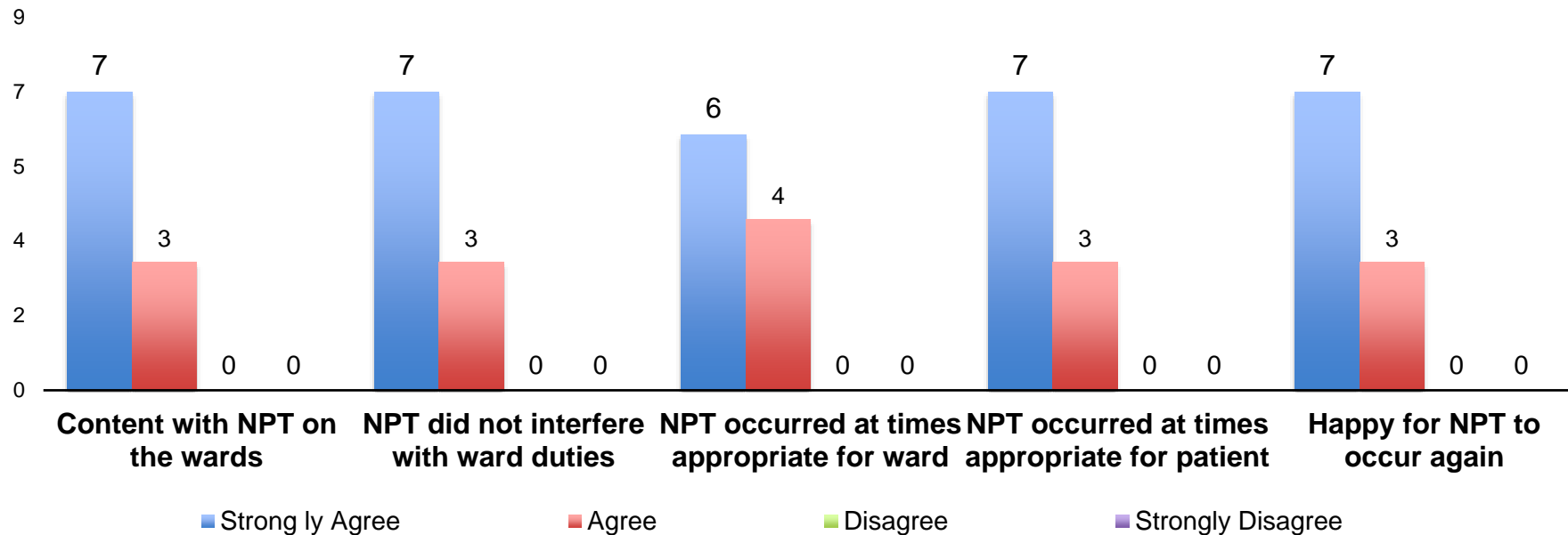

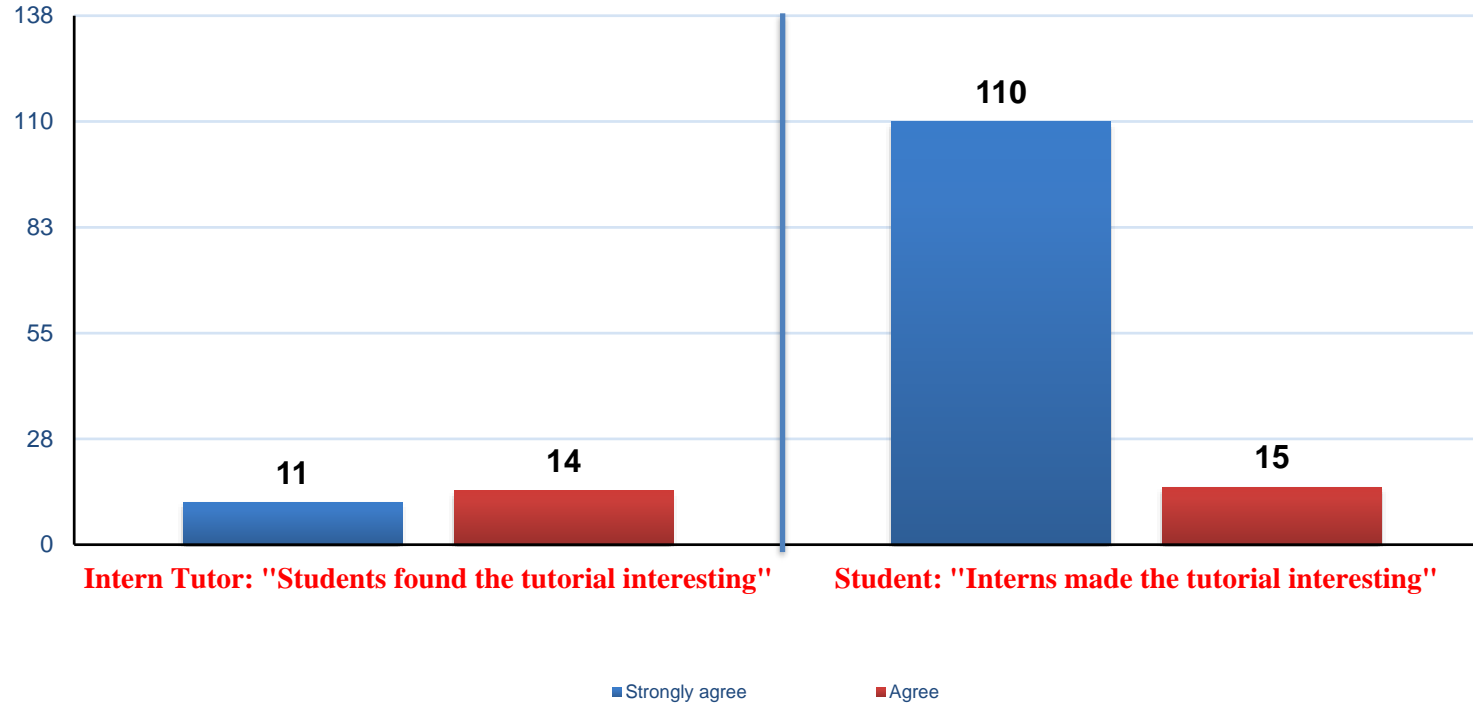

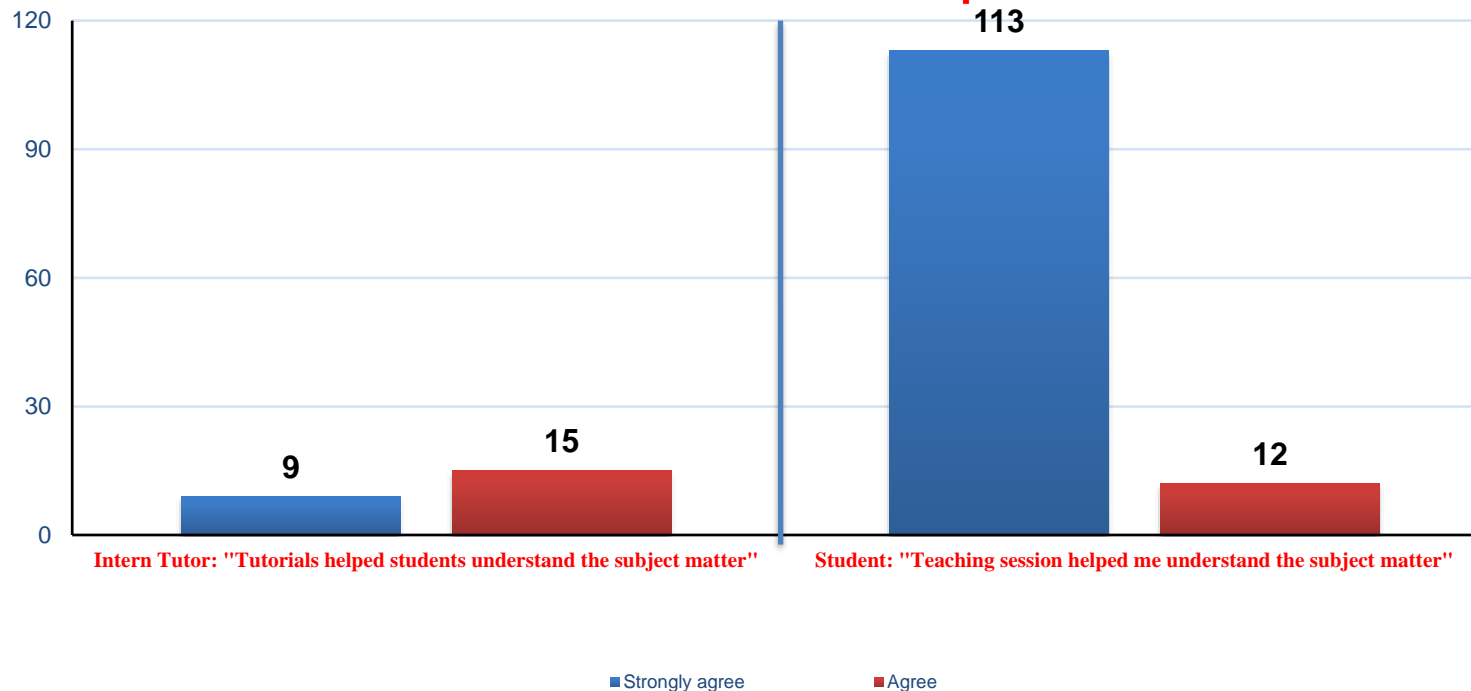

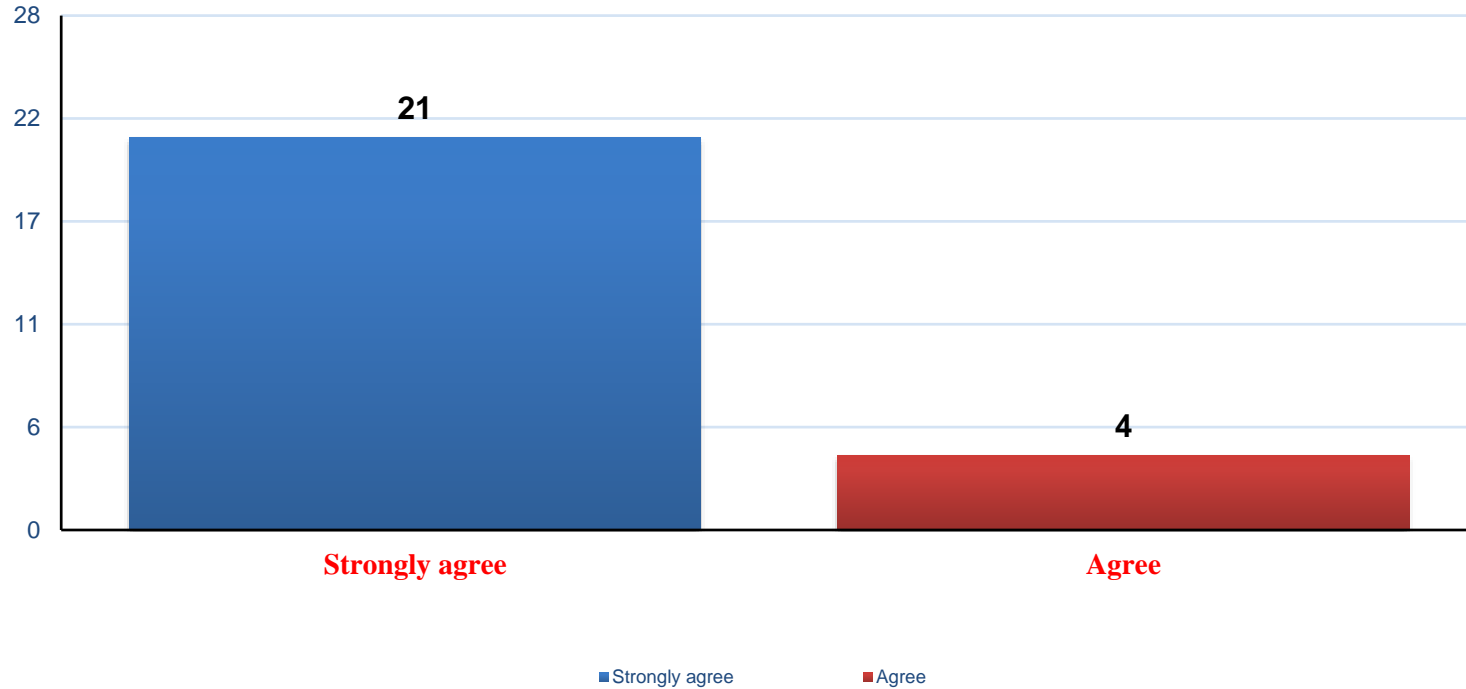

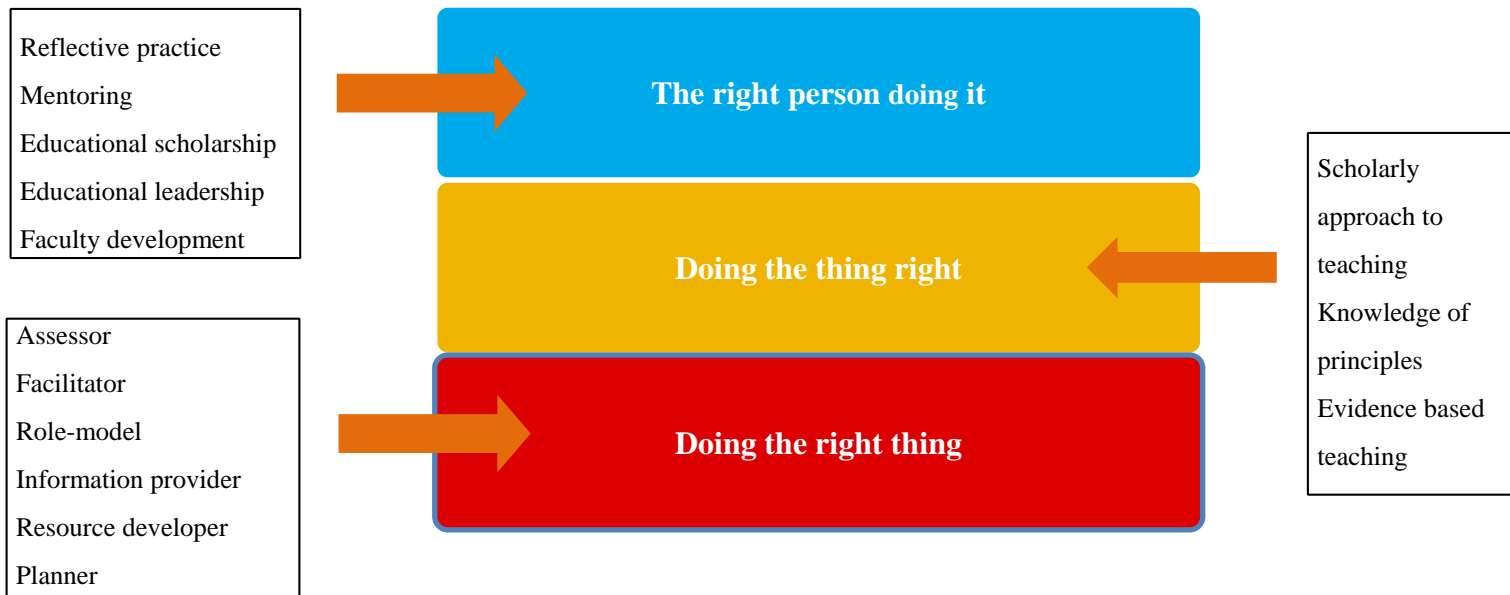
