



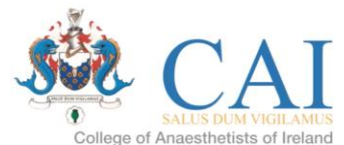

”

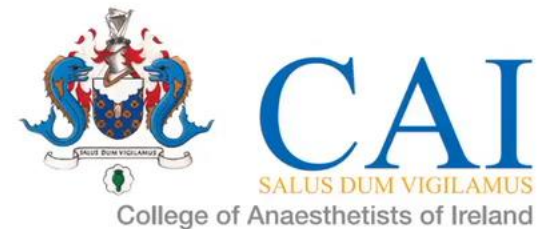

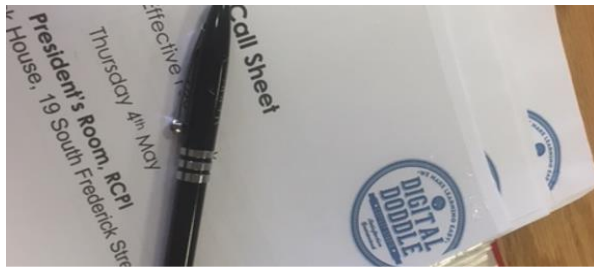

- ✓ Short and engaging.

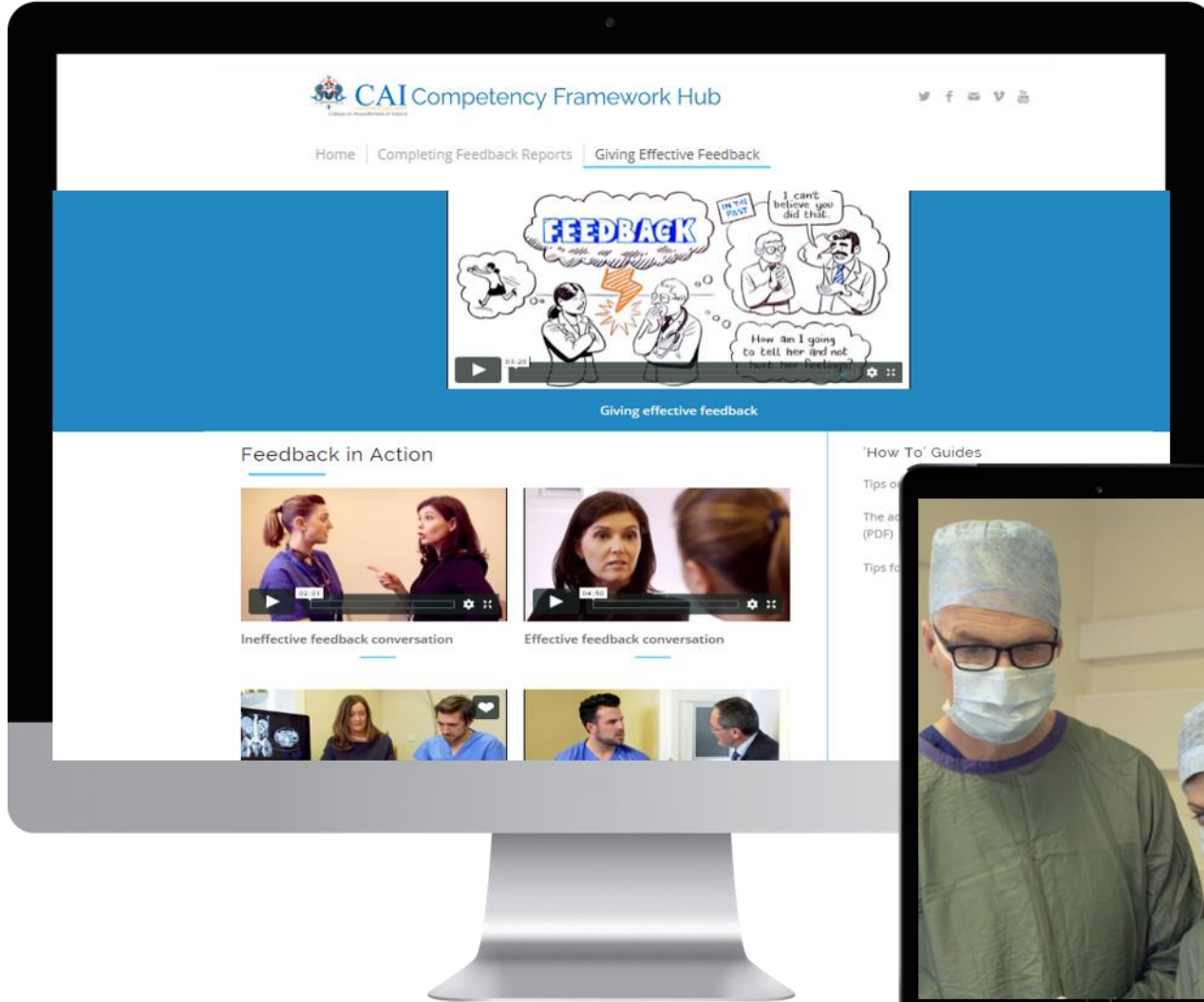
Benefits of Doctors Input

- ✓ Relationship building is key.
- ✓ Needs strong project management.
- ✓ Recruitment of doctors for acting roles - privacy issues.
- ✓ Scheduling face to face meetings.

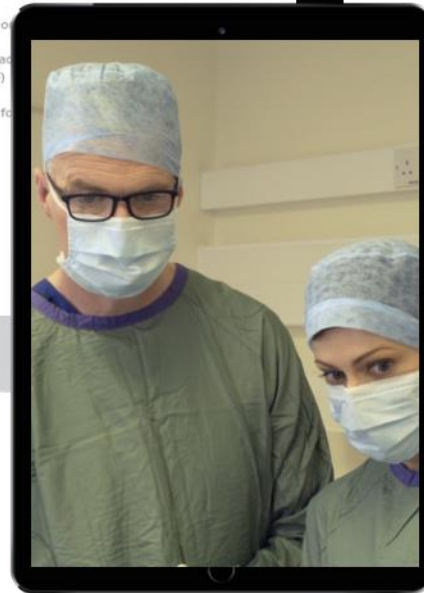




Impact
